# DAY ONE

Write your favorite dessert here:

 Mmmm ... don't you love dessert? You could probably survive without it, but aren't you glad God created it? He must really love us to give us more than spinach and tuna fish. It's true—God DOES love us ... so much that He sent His Son Jesus to be our Savior. Jesus told a whole group of people exactly what God's love is like—like a shepherd searching for a lost sheep, or a woman searching for a lost coin. God loves everyone. He shows grace to each one of us. Grace is getting something great that you don't deserve. God gives us the GIFT of salvation—it isn't something we can earn on our own. # DAY TWO


Read John 3:16.

Why did God send Jesus? Because He loves everyone. God loved the world so much that He showed huge, monumental, God-sized GRACE. He gave us a great and undeserved gift: Jesus, our Savior.

Flip this card over and draw a picture of the world.

Can you draw all the continents? Even Antarctica?



God is BIG. He loves the whole world  and He shows His grace to everyone.


THANK God for His grace: for giving us a Savior we didn't deserve.

# DAY FOUR

Find 1 John 4:19. Whisper it to yourself 3 times.

God loved us first. That's why we can love others. Grace is like that, too: God shows us grace, and He wants us to show grace to others, even if they don't deserve it.

Jesus came for everyone, and we can show others what God's grace is like by the way we act. How cool is that?


Make a batch of cookies with your mom or dad; they can be slice-and-bake or "from scratch."  Eat a couple, but give the rest to your neighbor.

ASK God to help you show grace to others by the way you treat them.

Read Romans 8:39.

You are valuable to God. Did you know that? He wants a relationship with YOU. God shows us grace by pursuing us—going on a quest to "find" us. He wants to save each one of us and draw us closer to Him. And nothing can separate us from His love.
